- 1927 John and I went to Fair Haven June 1st, 1927.

- John went to school at Miami Univ. at Oxford, O.
- John & I went to Cincinnati to see Martha.
- July 1928 We went to Fair Haven. Martha came home with us.
- 1929 Aug. 1929. John and I went to Niagara Falls and into Canada. Martha came in Aug. the day of the Farm Bureau Pageant at Cady.
- 1930 June 1930. My mother came to our house. She stayed about 15 days.
- Aug. 1930 John and I went to Fair Haven. Martha came back with us. We stopped at the State Fair.
- 1931 Martha came in May and stayed nine weeks.
- Aug. 1931 Mother Thompson, John and I went to the State Fair. We met Mae and Glenn there. Mae had 4-H youngster with her.
- May 1932 John and I went to Fair Haven. We stayed one week.
- We attended Uncle Will's Birthday Party with Mae and her family.
- Spent Sunday night and Decoration Day with Lenevieve Weisenborn in Larke County.
- 1933 June 15, 1933. We went to Mae's and returned home June 30, 1933. John and I went to Cincinnati.

Aug. 28, 1940. John, Lois and I made a business trip to Columbus  
on Wed. 28th and returned home Thursday. Visited  
with Mr. & Mrs. Tilton in Newcomerstown on our way ~~home~~.

1941. John, Lois and I went to Fair Haven Aug. 5th.  
On Aug. 6th we went to Hamilton to see Aileen  
On Thurs. Aug. 7th we went to the County Fair  
in Eston. Sat. Aug. 9th Visited with Nellie Hays,  
was home or him. Aug. 10th. John, Lois and I attended  
U.P. Church on Sunday. On Fri. Aug. 11th we  
visited out at the Farm. On Monday Aug. 11th  
we went to Lynn, Ind. to visit Geneva and

family. Had a good chicken dinner. Called at Huston's to see Myron but found no one at home. Tues. Aug. 12<sup>th</sup> called on Marie Snape and family. In the evening went to Mrs. Merideth's for Martha. Attended Ice cream social at U. P. Church later Aug. 13<sup>th</sup>. John, Lois and I came home to Jewett. Martha came to Jewett on Wed. Morning Aug. 20 and returned to Cincy on Fri. P. M.

G. W. J. went to O. V. G. H. at Wheeling on Tues., Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> to have two Wisdom teeth pulled. Was in the hospital five days. Lois stayed with Aunt Ruth and Lucy.

Mother Steele had a stroke of Paralysis about 2:00 A. M. Friday Morning Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup>, Sat. Martha was home on Friday P. M.

I received word of her illness on Sat. night. Lois and I went to Preble County on Tues. Nov. 4<sup>th</sup>. I helped Martha care for Mother.

On Sat. Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> John came for us in the car. John, Lois and I came back to Jewett on Sunday the 16<sup>th</sup>. Mother passed away on Tues. evening Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>. About 5:15 P. M. I went back to Preble Co. by train Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>. Mother was buried on Fri. P. M. Nov. 20<sup>th</sup>. Services held at the Fair Haven U. P. Church. Buried in Fair Haven Cemetery. Rev. Mac Roy, Pastor. Martha and I ate duck dinner at Marie Snape's home on Sat. Nov. 22<sup>nd</sup>. It was Nellie Hays 55<sup>th</sup> birthday. Nellie was there. I returned home to Jewett Nov. 27<sup>th</sup>. Ruth stayed with Lois and John.

1942. John, Lois and I went to Eaton on Tues. April 28<sup>th</sup>. Martha came to Eaton on Wed. April 29<sup>th</sup>. Business trip. We called on Nellie Hays and found her in bed. Had been in bed for eight weeks. Took Martha to Cincinnati on Fri. May 1<sup>st</sup> and stayed all day.

Jewett on Sat. May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1942.

Had a sore leg on returning <sup>home</sup> and Lucy was here  
and did the work from Monday until Fri. P.M.

Aug. 14 On Friday Aug. 14<sup>th</sup> Lois and I went to Cincinnati to  
visit Aunt Martha. On Sat. Aug. 15<sup>th</sup> Martha, Lois  
and I went to Hamilton, Oxford and took a taxi up  
to see Nellie Hayes. Sunday Martha had to work.  
On Monday Aug. 17<sup>th</sup> Martha, Lois and I went  
to Eaton by train on business, called on Mrs. Ramsey  
Young (Mrs. Tusco Young), Blanche Duvall Miller  
of Eldorado. Saw Mr. H. S. but was not talking to  
him. On Tues. Aug. 18<sup>th</sup> Lois and I came home to  
Jewett. Then on Thurs. Aug. 20<sup>th</sup> Martha came  
to Jewett to visit until Wed. Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> then returned  
home to 8209 Vine St. Cincy, O.

Dec. 7, 1942. On Dec. 7, 1942 Aunt Martha came to  
Jewett to spend Christmas vacation. Martha,  
John, Lois and I ate Christmas dinner at J. M.  
Thompson's. Had a very enjoyable Holiday  
Season. Martha returned to 8209 Vine St.

June 7, 1943.

1944 June 23, 1944 John, Lois and I left Jewett for  
Cincinnati on June 23<sup>rd</sup> to visit Aunt Martha.  
Stiles, Walter and Lucy took us to Dennis' car  
to get the train. We arrived in Cincinnati  
about 6:30 P.M. Fri. evening. On Tues. June  
27<sup>th</sup> John, Lois and I went from Cincy to  
Camden on the train and Charles Williams  
took us out to Arthur Haag. Arthur and  
Nellie took us to Eaton and we had dinner  
at Wagner's Kitchen. Had a lovely dinner.  
They took us down to Camden to catch  
the train back to Cincy that evening.  
We came back to Jewett on Thurs. June 29,  
1944.

We spent most of the summer from  
Mon. July 1<sup>st</sup> to Fri. July 26<sup>th</sup> at Ralph

Williamson's. We moved from Jewett to Carrollton on July 26<sup>th</sup> 1944.

John is teaching at Malvern this winter  
Sept. 19 45. John still teaching at Malvern.

Tues. A.M.

June 4, 1946. Martha Steele came to Carrollton to visit us. She was here until Evening June 7, John, Lois and I took Martha to Canton to get a bus back to Cincinnati. The bus left Canton about 6:00 P.M. Earl Palmer died Fri June 7, th and was buried Sun. June 9<sup>th</sup> 1946. John still teaching at Mal-

Aug. 6, 1946. John, Lois and I started on a little trip to Preble Co. Stayed in Eaton at tourist home Aug. 6<sup>th</sup>. Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> we met Martha at the Bus station in Hamilton. Were unable to locate Aileen so all four of us went to Oxford. Stopped at the cemetery, then called on Mrs. Merideth. Martha went up to College Corner with us and stopped at Jess Reiss. Lois, John and I spent Wed and Thurs. nights at Milton Irvin's homes. Visited on Thursday with Nellie Hays. Took dinner on Friday with Mabel Brown. Arrived at Geneva on Friday evening Aug. 9<sup>th</sup> and stayed there until Tues. A.M. Monday we called Nellie, Frances Hays and Marie Snape. Came home. Troy, Urbana, Delaware and Wooster. Arrived home Wed. evening Aug. 14<sup>th</sup> 1946.

Monday, May 26, 1947 Went to Mercy Hospital in Canton. May 27<sup>th</sup> Tues. Had an operation & returned home on June 8<sup>th</sup> (Sunday) Lois spent from May 30<sup>th</sup> to June 14<sup>th</sup> with Aunt Lucy and from June 16 to 28 with Aunt Nancy. July 17, Martha came on Thurs. A.M. to visit with us and left for New York on Tues. July 22<sup>nd</sup>. Called on Mary and Edna Lester Mon. eve 21<sup>st</sup>

Aug 21st. wt. 132 lb.)

Aug. 1947 Aug. 23rd went to Canton. Took gas and had 9 lower teeth extracted.

Aug. 26 & 27th John Thompson & John Harrison attended the Ohio State Fair.

Sept. 1947 John still teaching at Malvern.

July 15, 1948 Martha came over & visited with us from July 15 to 22nd. From here she went to New York City sight seeing.

Sat July 17, Ida Rees came in the evening and stayed all night. Sunday morning we took her down to Camp Muskingum. John, Lois, Martha and I ate dinner with Eleanor & Albert Kinsel. Nancy's were there. We visited the Scio pottery in the P.M. Called on Mary & Edna Demaster in the evening. John, Lois and I did not take a trip.

Aug. 25, 1949 Martha came over, arrived in Carrollton on Thurs. Morning was here until Tues. evening Aug. 30. From here she went to New York City. John, Lois and I did not take a trip.

June 1949 John bought his 1/2 ton truck.

Sept. 1949 John still teaching at Malvern.

July 1950 John, Lois and I started on a trip on Thurs. July 13, 1950. Went to Lebanon the first day and spent the night there.

Friday morning we went to Aileen's house in Hamilton (300 Harrison Avenue) Visited there with Martha, Aileen, Linda & Jackie Iglesias. Visited in the afternoon with Myron at Seven-mile Grain elevator.

May 19, 1950 Friday. I went from Canton to Hamilton by bus to attend the wedding of Miss Joan Lee Ward. Spent the night with Martha at Aileen's house. Came home on Sunday.

Sept. 9, 1950 Aunt Martha arrived in Carrollton Saturday evening and stayed until Sept. 14th. From here she went back to

Columbus to the Clinic.

Thursday Aug. 13, 1958 I entered Mercy Hospital and was there 5 days. On Fri. Sept. 1, I had a Bronchoscopy. On Sat. Metabolism test & X-ray. Came home on Tues. Sept. 5, 1958

Aug. 1951. On Sunday Aug. 26th John & I took Lois down to Aunt Lucy Bowers. She stayed there until wed. eve Aug. 29th. On Monday morn Aug. 27 John & I went to Columbus to the State Fair. Was at the Fair all afternoon and stayed for the night show. Saw the Horse Theft Show. Tues. A.M. Called Cileen on Telephone. Aunt Martha was there. John & I went to Hamilton and spent part of the P.M. and was there for supper. About 9:00 P.M. John, Aunt Martha & I went to Cincy & spent the night with her in her apartment. Wed. morning all three of us went out to Breakfast then Martha went back to her apartment & we came home.

1950 John & I also called on Joan Kettell Friday. Spent Fri. night at Cliff McDills in Oxford. Sat. eve we went to College corner & Fair Haven, called on Martha Trelson, Mabel Brown, Mack Parks, Calvin, Maggie & Martha Wilson, Charley & Mabel Williams. Spent Sat. night in Camden, visited Lucy Ramsey at Martha Keller's home. Also Annie & Bert Ramsey.

Sunday attended Sunday School & Church at the Fair Haven U.P. Church. Sunday afternoon we went to Richmond Ind. to Arthur Hay's home and spent the night there. Parker, Marie & Tommy Sarge took supper there also. Monday A.M. Drove through Earlham Cemetery. Called on Milton Irwin. Took dinner in Eaton. Went back to Yellow then on to Genevaevs Mon. P.M.

Wed. A.M. Started to Chicago. Spent the

night in Berwick, Ill. Thurs. spent the day in downtown Chicago. Visited Tower-Drivin family. Thurs. night, Fri. drove down South Lake shore Drive and visited in Hall of Arts & Sciences and back to Geneva on that night. Came home Monday July 24th. Made a short call on Miss Brock on July 24th.

Aug. 12, 1952 On Aug. 10, 1952 the Elwood Adams family had dinner at our house then in the afternoon all of us drove to Zanesville. In the evening Lois went home with Elwood for a weeks visit. On Thurs. Aug. 12, John took me to Canton and I went to Hamilton by bus. Aileen & Jaque took me to Cincinnati to Martha's apartment at Kunkle Corners 1409 Hamilton Ave., Ida Pees came on Wed. morning. In the afternoon we went to the zos. That night, Martha, Ida & I went to the zos again. On Thurs. night Martha,



Ida & I went to a picture show. On Fri. Ida, Rose & I went to Ida's cabin in Loveland Park. I spent the night there. On Sat. P.M. Ida & I went to Hamilton. Met Maude Paap there. I went back to Cincinnati on the t Sat. Night Martha & I went to a show. Vis at her Apartment all day Sunday. Started h at 6:30 A.M. and arrived in Canton about 5:30 P.M. Bought Lois a winter coat before we came home.

Sat. Aug. 27th Myron got to our place about 7: A.M. He had traveled all night to get here. He started back to Norfolk on Sunday about 2:30 Myron was discharged from the Navy about Sept. 16th He went to Halifax, Nova. I



## Robert Taylor Steele (1852-1926)

Robert Taylor Steele, son of Samuel Steele and Martha Hayes Steele was born on March 23, 1852 in Israel Township, Preble County, Ohio. He attended school at Do Not Know.

Robert Steele was married on April 19, 1893 to Emma Winifred Irvin. Five children blessed this marriage; Robert Blaine, Mae Cline, Harry Knop, Martha Gillespie and Georgia Winifred. The Steeles lived for many years on the Robert Steele farm, now owned and operated by his son Harry which is located about two miles east of Fair Haven, Ohio.

In February 1926, Robert Taylor Steele was retired from the farm and moved with his wife to a home in Fair Haven where he passed away.

32. Mae Cline Steele (1896-1937)

Mae Cline Steele, daughter of Robert Taylor Steele and Emma Irwin Steele, was born on the Steele farm about two miles east of Fair Haven, Preble County, Ohio, on February 29, 1896. She attended Grade school at Ramsey and Beech Hill Schools and High School at Fair Haven and Dixon Township High school, now known as Dixon Israel Consolidated school, from which she graduated in 1916 (1916).

Mae then attended Normal School at West Alexandria, Ohio, and prepared for teaching. She also attended Summer School at Miami University. Mae taught Elementarist at Ritzville, Hamlin.

On December 28, 1921, Mae Steele was married to Glenn Weston. From this marriage children were born: Aileen Frances, and my husband Harold. The family lived for several years on a farm south of Oxford, Ohio, between Oxford and Mc Goshen. Here Mae died on August 13, 1937. She was buried in the cemetery at
